insert and tighten down all the fasteners
remove that plug for the fan switch
top off the coolant
reinstall the splash shield

Dispose old coolant and put wheel back on car

Fill radiator up to filler neck

Leave radiator cap off and start car for 30 seconds

Fill radiator to filler neck and reservoir to max fill line

Put reservoir and radiator caps on

Start car and let run until fans turn on at least twice

Let car cool down

Carefully remove radiator cap

Fill radiator to filler neck and reservoir to max fill line

Put radiator and reservoir caps back on

Take your car on a drive to work or school

Let car cool 100% until cold to the touch

Fill reservoir to max fill line
